*Scary Submission* Read Genesis 16:1—18:15 about Abraham & Sarah.

Is submission frightening to you? What lawful thing has your husband asked you to do that has scared you? Have you ever mocked your husband's dreams? How did it work out when Sarah lacked humility and trust in Abraham? Since she is used as an example of a godly wife, what hope does this give to you?

*Mind Your Prayers* Read these passages in 1 Peter: 1:13, 2:8, 3:8, 4:7, 5:8

What fills your thoughts about your suffering? Do you play dramatic worst-case scenarios in your mind, or rosy visions of victory? Read Philippians 4:8 and journal what is true, honorable, right, pure, about the trial you find yourself in today. Read 2 Corinthians 10:5. How do you take thoughts captive?

*Be Reconciled* Peter Read Matthew 5:23-24. Is a broken relationship hindering your prayers? What can you do right now to be reconciled, to "seek peace and pursue it" (1 Peter 3:11)?

*Sweet Hour of Prayer* Read Mark 14:37-41. Can you pray for one hour this week?
